Health & Safety

To prevent any and all communicable diseases, we ask that you please keep your child home if they are feeling ill. If a child becomes sick at school they will be given a mask and will wait in the medical room until picked up. We ask that they not return until they feel better or medical advice has been sought. Please make arrangements to have someone available to pick up students at any time throughout the day should it be necessary.

Staff will continue the practice of wearing district identification badges so that they are recognized as safe adults for students in the school and on the playground. Also, staff on supervision outside before school, at recess, lunch and after school will wear high visibility vests to make them easy for students to locate should they need assistance. Parents and other adults are encouraged not to be on the grounds during the school day as it is often difficult for our staff to know if an adult "belongs" on our grounds or not.

Band/Music

I am very pleased that the Delta School District will now be offering after an after-school band program at Sands Secondary for grade 6/7 students who are interested. You should have received an email on Friday from the School District with the details of the Band program offered .As a result, moving forward, Gray will provide music to grade 6/7 students instead of mandatory band.

Important Traffic Safety Routines

As you get into the routines of school drop off and pick-up for your child/ren, to keep all students safe, we would like to remind you of the following safety points:

- The school parking lot is for *staff only*. With the large number of staff members we have, we need to ensure that all have a place to park when they arrive.
- The drop off area is for DROP OFF only. We ask that you please have your child/ren ready to exit the car (backpacks and jackets ready) so that you do not need to leave the car.
- If you are driving and would still like to accompany your child/ren to their door, we encourage you to park your car on the side roads off of 80th Ave., or on the road beside Gray's main field (108th street).

We understand that on some days, traffic congestion, rough starts or other challenges may prevent your child/ren from arriving on time. We all have those kinds of mornings. Please take your time. Student safety is our greatest priority and we would rather students arrive safe, calm and secure than in a rushed state.

Administration of Medication:

Schools are required to maintain a safe procedure for dispensing medications. We would like to have information regarding medication administration within the first two weeks of school. If your child is required to take medication at school, please request a Request for Administration of Medication at School form from the office. These forms must be completed each year and are required to be signed by your physician.

Scent Sensitivity:

At Gray, we have staff who suffer from respiratory difficulties that are made worse by scented products. We ask that students, parents, and staff do what they can to avoid using scented aftershave, hair spray, cologne or other scented personal care products. Teachers within specific pods may send further information regarding this – please make an effort to honour any specific requests made in this regard. Thank you!
